Case Summary: (type of Hearing and just brief introduction to help the reader) Request for redress arising from being scored BFD

Procedural Matters, (Conflicts of Interest,, parties not present, extending time limits)

Facts found:

- 1. CRO 1 was identified at the start of race 4 in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark during the last minute before her starting signal.
- 2. CRO 1 was not listed on the board on the RC boat together with other boats similarly identified
- 3. CRO 1 was not aware of being scored BFD in Race 4 as other boats and sailed race 5.
- 4. RC determined from their own records that CRO 1 was scored incorrectly (finishing position instead of BFD) and corrected that error at around 8:30 p.m. the same day.

Conclusion & Rules:

- 1. There was an omission by the race committee by not displaying the sail number of CRO 1 amongst other BFD boats.
- 2. Not knowing the BFD in race 4 CRO 1 might have chosen a different strategic approach planning his race as if he had known about the BFD, however that did not make his score significantly worse through no fault of his own.
