<p>Case Summary: (type of Hearing and just brief introduction to help the reader) Taking a penalty and keeping clear.</p>
<p>Procedural Matters, (Conflicts of Interest, parties not present, extending time limits) SUI 1 was not represented at the hearing. Hearing held under RRS 63.3(b).</p>
<p>Facts found:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. SUI 1 started sailing the first downwind of race 9 on starboard tack. 2. SUI 1 started to take a Two-Turns Penalty by gybing. 3. SUI 1 completed his second tack and was on starboard tack again. 4. GRE 77, also on starboard, overlapped to windward of SUI 1 then bore away.
<p>Conclusion & Rules:</p> <p>GRE 77 a boat on the same tack overlapped to windward kept clear of SUI 1 as required by RRS 11. As per Case 108, SUI 1 completed her penalty turn before GRE 77 changed course, and therefore she did not break RRS 22.2.</p>
<p>Decision:</p> <p>Protest is dismissed.</p>
